

Announcement of Special Service Area #25 Commissioner Search

The Little Village 26th Street Area Chamber of Commerce, sole provider to the Little Village Special Service Area#25 (SSA#25) is currently accepting Commissioner Applications to fill the non-paid role of appropriating SSA #25 funds.

Special Service Areas, known as Business Improvement Districts that fund expanded services and programs through a localized property tax levy within contiguous areas.

The enhanced services and programs are in addition to those currently provided through the city.

The Little Village Special Service Area #25 is charged with the responsibility of using this economic development tool to assist in cleaning, beautifying and revitalizing the Little Village commercial corridors.

SSA #25 Commissioners typically review the budgets and contracts that help to better the retail corridors in the little village.

The SSA #25 Boundaries are:

- *25th St. from Lawndale Ave. to Troy St.*
- *26th St. from California Ave. to Kenton Ave.*
- *31st St. from Springfield Ave. to Karlov Ave.*
- *Kedzie Ave. from 31st St. to 24th*
- *Pulaski Ave. from 31st St. to Cermak Rd.*

QUALIFICATIONS:

SSA Commissioner Applicant must either be a resident in the district or business/property owner in the district. Every commission member should be prepared to serve for at least 2 years with the ability to renew at the end of that time.

The nominating committee strives to maintain a varied make-up on the commission (large and small business, residents, etc.) to represent the range of interest and viewpoints within the SSA #25 interested, eligible individuals can contact the Little Village Chamber of Commerce at 773.521.5387.

Commissioners are appointed by the mayor of the City of Chicago with the approval of City Council.

Applications are due no later than May 31, 2017.
