- Follow all City and State safety guidelines to stop the spread of COVID - 19
- Event must take place within Little Village Special Service Area #25 boundaries
- **SHOP LOCAL** with SSA #25 sponsored funds
- Special Event flyer/posters must showcase "SSA #25" logo
- Art work needed 2 months before the event (Advertising Purposes)
- Event Reporting: 1-page summary with the highlights, attendance, event images, expense report with receipts copies (Due 90 days after the event took place).

### SSA #25 Boundaries:

- 25th St. from Lawndale Ave. to Troy St.
- 26th St. from California Ave. to Kenton Ave.
- 31st St. from Springfield Ave. to Karlov Ave.
  - Kedzie Ave. from 31st St. to 24th
  - Pulaski Ave. from 31st St. to Cermak
